Entry and Eligibility

Entry is open to all members of MYA affiliated Clubs and to members of foreign clubs affiliated to a Delegated National Member of IRSA. [Enter using the on line entry form.](#)

all entries to include name, address, MYA affiliated club, hull number, jib number, frequency, and emergency contact details. Entries close at 21.00hrs 30/10/2019 after which time entries may be received at the discretion of the club and subject to a late entry fee.

Entry Fees - Event entry fees are £5 payable on the day. Registration will take place from 0830 hours in the E&DMYC clubhouse. Current IOM class certificates and if applicable, valid personal sail number certificates, are to be presented.

Sailing Instructions – The event will be governed by:-

- Racing Rules of Sailing (as amended by RRS Appendix E)
- Equipment Rules of Sailing
- MYA Standard Sailing Instructions
- International One Metre Class Rules

- HMS.

The Race Officer reserves the right to use observers drawn from the competitors.

A protest committee will be appointed by the Race Committee to hear any protests arising from the event and will comprise of competitors not involved in the relevant heat in which the incident is alleged to have occurred.

Entry List, Sail Numbers and Frequency Allocation – will be displayed on the race management notice board and posted on the EDMYC website event page (this is a manual process and may take a few days for your entry to appear on the list). Competitors will be notified of necessary changes in the event of a clash of sail numbers.

GDPR requires the entrants consent to the use of personal data for compiling results and event reports for publication via the MYA and on social media. Please indicate your consent in the tick box provided.

Disclaimer

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states, “The responsibility for a boats decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is theirs alone”. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk, by taking part in the event each competitor agrees and acknowledges this and they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.
